



Experience making wagashi, or Japanese-style sweets, while watching a demonstration by a seasoned expert in the craft. Then taste the fruit of your labors during a tea ceremony. > Approx. 90 min.

Sit back and enjoy a live musical performance as 15 to 20 men and women fire up your group with lively rhythms and dance moves. You can also try the *awaodori* dance yourself after the performance. > Approx. 15-20 min

10. Ninja Warriors & Kimono Girls

Enjoy a presentation of ninja techniques that have been passed down over many years as part of this traditional martial art.



Experience Japanese hospitality as offered by women wearing traditional white makeup, Japanese-style hairdos, and long-sleeved kimonos. You won't want to miss the spectacle as the group performs a Japanese-style dance.

1. Japanese Calligraphy Performance with Live Japanese Music



Enjoy a powerful presentation in which a performer writes characters on enormous sheets of paper while accompanied by a live performance of Japanese instruments. > Approx. 15-20 min

**2. Sumo Event** Lecture by Former Professional Sumo Wrestler & Sumo Workshop



Watch as former sumo wrestlers stage a presentation of some of the sport's techniques. The sound

of two wrestlers coming together in the ring is powerful. You can face off against a sumo wrestler yourself! > Approx. 60-75 min

**3. Kabuki Performance** *Renjishi,* the Father and Son Lions Dance with Live Musical Accompaniment & *Kagura Daija,* The Great Snake Dance



Watch as two kabuki entertainers perform traditional dances known as *renjishi* and *kagura-daija* with live musical accompaniment. > Approx. 15-20 min

#### 4. Ikebana Flower Arrangement

Performance with Live Japanese Music



Enjoy flower arrangement as performance art on a huge scale in this collaboration of *ikebana* practitioners with a live performance of traditional Japanese music including *shamisen* and folk music. > Approx. 15-20 min

**5.** Special *Taiko* Performance & Kimono Girls



watch as a group of 7 drummer stages a powerful *taiko* drum performance.

> Approx. 15-20 min

6. Awaodori Dance Performance & Kimono Girls



Sit back and enjoy the show as 25 to 30 male and female dancers accompanied by live music fire up your group. You can try dancing yourself after the performance. > Approx. 15-20 min

#### 1. Japanese Traditional Noh Entertainment

Enjoy the traditional dance of Noh, a classical Japanese art form that has been designated an Intangible World Heritage by UNESCO.

#### 2. Kabuki Entertainment Show

*Renjishi*, Lion Dance with Live Musical Accompaniment & *Kagura Daija*, The Great Snake Dance

Enjoy a kabuki-themed show featuring *kagura-daija* and *renjishi* dances, kabuki illusion magic, and ninja action performances. > Approx. 20-30 min

We can assist overseas organizers and planners who are planning corporate meetings and incentive tours in Tokyo by defraying the costs associated with advance visits to the city, including airfare, lodging, and local transportation. Please contact TCVB for more information.

#### Remark

- The application should be submitted at least 1 month prior to the arrival in Tokyo and no later than FEB 29, 2016. Applicant should be either event owner (a company) or a meeting planner located overseas.
- Only groups with overseas attendees who have not finalized the location
  of their event at the time of application but who plan to spend 100
  visitor-nights or more in Tokyo once their plans are finalized are eligible to
  participate in these programs.
- TCVB may close enrollment in programs early if bookings for the fiscal year exceed the number of programs it has planned, even if the final application deadline has not yet passed.
- Some programs are subject to limitations in terms of how many people can participate at once or of venue capacity. Please contact TCVB for more information.
- Please note that all information provided in this pamphlet is tentative in nature and that it may not be possible to arrange your desired program depending on conditions at the time of application.
