#### Mount Takao (Takaosan)

Mt. Takao attracts 2.6 million visitors annually for the seasonal beauty of nature and has received three stars from the Michelin Green Guide as a "Must Go" sight.



# Temple

Founded in 744 by Gyoki on the order of Emperor Shomu. Yakuo-in grew under the patronage of the ruling Tokugawa family during Edo period (1603–1867).



#### Edo-Tokyo Open Air Architectural Museum

A showcase featuring buildings of historically and culturally significance dating from the early Edo to Showa eras (1650s-1950s) that have been relocated and rebuilt.



#### Kushi Kanzashi Museum

This unique museum displays
Japanese women's hair
accessories. It is amazing that
the essence of Japanese
culture has been expressed in
these small ornaments.



# Ozawa Shuzo (Sake Brewery)

The brewery offers you spectacular views of the surrounding mountains and valleys. "Sawanoi", one of their signature brands, has clean, crisp flavor and refined aroma.



#### Ishikawa Shuzo (Sake Brewery)

You will see the beauty of the old kura-warehouse. "Tama-jiman" (Pride of Tama) sake and "Tama no Megumi" (Gift of Tama) draft beer are made using only local ingredients.



#### POMONA Membership Farm

This farm demonstrates how to grow vegetables as well as offering land for rental. Enjoy picking seasonal vegetables and grill them for your lunch.



#### Toshimaya Shuzo (Sake Brewery)

Established in 1596. Their signature sake "Kinkon", which has been awarded numerous gold prizes, is dedicated to the Meiji Jingu and Kanda Myojin Shrines as the sacred sake.
