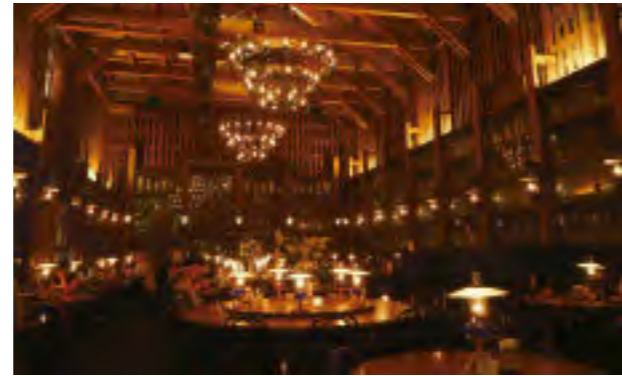

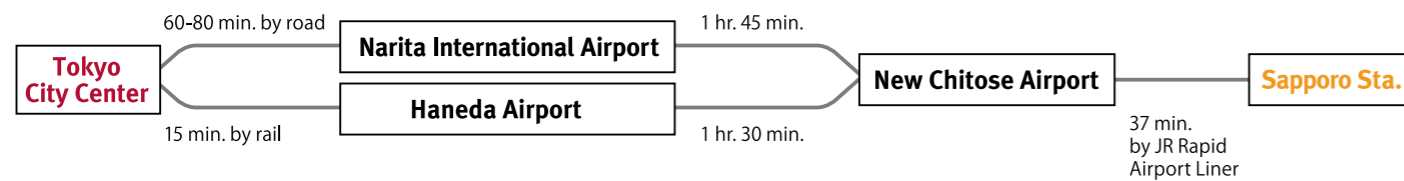


Tokyo-Sapporo One of the Most Active Air Routes in the World

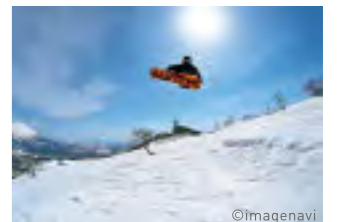
